DRIVERS: Please obey the State School Bus Stopping Law

The PA School Bus Stopping Law requires all drivers to take the following actions:

- *When you meet or overtake a stopped school bus w/red signal lights flashing & stop arm extended, you MUST STOP*
- *When you approach an intersection where a school bus is stopped w/red signal lights flashing & arm extended, you MUST STOP*
- *You MUST STOP 10 ft away & MUST WAIT until red lights have stopped flashing & arm has been withdrawn before moving*

**IF CONVICTED 60 DAY LICENSE SUSPENSION, \$250. FINE & 5PTS ON RECORD*

Attention Members:

For leaf collection, you must rake your leaves (**FRONT YARD ONLY**)

DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF YOUR PROPERTY.

NOTHING OTHER THAN LEAVES WILL BE COLLECTED; PLEASE DO NOT RAKE BRANCHES OR TWIGS IN WITH THE LEAVES.

Do not bag leaves. If you have a drainage ditch in front of you property **DO NOT** put leaves in the ditch.

The maintenance crew will go through the different stages each week, weather permitting to vacuum up the leaves and haul them away.

Homeowners please remember that you are responsible for keeping your Culvert Pipes free and clear of debris.

Maintenance will be going around and checking on Culvert pipes as they pick up leaves.

CURRENTLY ON STAGE(S) "7" OF LEAVE PICK-UP

Please have leaves ready as maintenance will not be going back around!!!
